Curriculum Aspects:

- The following 5 programmes are running in the college.
 - B.A. 3 year programme with an intake of 240 students.
 - B.Com- 3 year programme with an intake of 80 students.
 - M.Com.-2 year programme with an intake of 40 students.
 - M.A. Geography-2 year programme with an intake of 40 students.
 - M.A. Hindi-2 year programme with an intake of 40 students.
- Total strength of students in the college at present is 903.
- Total no. of sanctioned teaching posts are 25 against which 18 faculty members are working (12 regular + 07 extension lecturer) as on date. Most importantly, the faculty post for Economics is vacant.
- The syllabi of all the above-mentioned courses of the college are in accordance with Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak course curriculum framework.
- The emphasis of teaching in addition to theoretical knowledge is also laid on enhancing the computer skills and overall personality development of the students.

- The feedback from the students, parents, alumni and the teachers were taken time to time in form of the feedback obtained through online feedback proforma and suggestions were also incorporated accordingly.
- The college has a fully automated library equipped with 4159 number of books.
- The students have free accessibility to meet the Principal of the college as well as other faculty members whenever required.

Teaching-Learning Aspects:

- Every year admission to all programmes is made by D.G.H.E and M.D.University, Rohtak guidelines and norms as per schedule fixed by them through online system.
- Apart from regular examinations, the college has its own examination cell that strictly follows university norms for continuous evaluation of students in the form of class tests, assignments, regular presentations and group discussion.
- Tutorials/Mentoring classes are also conducted for the overall academic improvement and personality development of the students.
- Mentor - Mentee ratio is 1:44 (Very High).
- The future plan for the next academic year is still to be finalized to initiate and strengthen value adding facilities/practices for the students, faculty members and the college as a whole.

Infrastructure and Learning Resources:

- The college is well equipped with different types of laboratories such as Geography and Computer labs.
- 5 Smart Class rooms are available with latest facilities.
- 22 CCTV Cameras have been installed at different locations in the college.
- Rooms for House Examination, Career Counseling & Guidance Cell, ICC, SC/ST Cell, Sports, NSS, First Aid, Mini Kitchen Room etc are available to facilitate the students.
- The college has ramp and toilet facilities for physically challenged persons.
- The college has also water coolers attached with purifier system.
- The Parking Area for staff and students is available with shed.

Detail of Activities (2024-25)
